INTRODUCTION

The Schools & Homes Energy Education Project/Solar-Active (a registered social enterprise, charity and a not-for-profit limited company by guarantee) primary aim is to raise the awareness of how energy efficiency and renewable technologies work; in order for one to make informed decisions of their energy use at home and work.

In July 2013, production of Inno-Therm® transferred to [Le Relais](#) offering in UK and for export, Metisse® under Inno-Therm® brand. Recovery Insulation became the sole UK agent for Le Relais to sell and distribute Inno-therm®/[Metisse®](#). In February 2016 Recovery Insulation became a trading arm of the charity.

- Solar-Active has been developing since 1993, an approach to learning & teaching and Solar STEM resources (i.e. solar model car/boat, lorry, hydrofoil, clock and mini-pump, home & school energy surveys, dynamic interactive website) and working demonstrations [i.e. solar water heating unit, off-grid PV and wind turbine assembly] that focuses on stimulating student's interest and involves real life applications of scientific concepts.

- The hands-on STEM resources were tailored for teacher professional development to create a solid grounding in the core principles of climate change science in young people and people of all ages to inspire positive action in their school communities.
- The teaching approach and STEM resources developed made learning and teaching enjoyable, acquiring knowledge and problem solving skills in renewable energy technologies while valuing failure. Our view is that failure is necessary as it is life's great teacher - without failure, great achievements are rarely made.
- The problem? Schools will often celebrate primarily the successes rather than also highlighting success that are filled with trials and setbacks. (re: [**Telegraph article: Learning Through Trial and Error**](#) – published 20th April, 2017.
- During 2018/19, solar car design challenges have again been cancelled due to government cuts to Local Authorities in education budgets and focus on exams.

WHAT HAS BEEN ACHIEVED

In house lamination of solar-active cells has now been completed; too bespoke our flexible cells for use in our STEM solar education resources and new commercial products [i.e. mobile phone recharge unit]. The cells have been successfully tested. The double cell will 1st be used on 1st June 2019 in The Netherlands at a solar boat challenge.




Figure 4: double cell

SOLAR MOBILE PHONE RECHARGE UNIT

In 2018 we were given 12 sacks of what we thought contained only denim cut offs from the making of denim shorts. I found 100 pairs of old jeans, 40 shorts and 6 sacks of cut offs. We now offer a free pair of old (many are 501) denim jeans or on request when insulation is purchased and they are also [for sale](#).

We are seeking funding to complete the next stages in the development of a wearable solar mobile phone recharge unit using our flexible solar cell integrated into a garment made from the recycled offcuts of denim jeans. The electronic component has successfully been tried and tested as a working prototype.

This phase is to involve students from secondary schools, university/college textile course; with the production of the garment to involve an x-offenders enterpriser project within the UK prison service.



Recovery Insulation Ltd. is a social enterprise/for profit share capitol company established in 2002 by [Schools & Homes Energy Education Project/Solar-Active](#) with investment from [The Keyfund](#) and support from the Sheffield Community Enterprise Development Unit [SCEDU]. The main aim is to have manufactured low carbon non-itch recycled cotton high performance thermal and acoustic insulation. This has been accomplished with Le Relais, another social enterprise.



As a social enterprise, we stand apart from other insulation companies in having donated a proportion of our sales income to the education charity Schools & Homes Energy Education Project/Solar-Active to conduct renewable and energy efficiency activities in educational establishments, youth groups and general public.

In 2019 we were in a position to donate £ to Solar-Active, used for The Netherlands solar boat challenges and in the development of the Solar-Active PV cells.

In the manufacture of our thermal and acoustic insulation Recovery Insulation with Le Relais LLC fully addresses the economic and supply chain implications in the implementation of the principles of the Circular Economy

Availability and Applications

- Approved for use in lofts, floors, walls and sarking.
- Thermal available in rolls and batts - 50 mm (£3.38/m²), 80mm, 100 mm (£6.70/m²), 120 mm (£7.74&£8.88/m²) and batts only 145 mm (£9.10&£10.46/m²), and 200 mm (£12.08/m²), density of rolls at 20 kg/m³ and batts at 20/25 kg/m³
- Acoustic available in 45mm batts (£6.32/m²) and 20mm rolls (£3.55/m²). Thermal/acoustic available in 50mm batts or rolls (£4.41/m²).
- Using Flock depends on the R value targeted.

WHAT HAS BEEN ACHIEVED

- In January 2019 invited by Herringthorpe Junior School to participate in their Nemesis project to design recycled denim products (e.g. braided denim rugs, bag, proggie mats or denim place mats) from vintage denim jeans and leg off-cuts
- NEMESIS represents a new approach towards attainment of social innovation skills by combining innovative learning models, technologies, and participatory

relations and processes. The objective is to foster entrepreneurial mind sets and creative thinking among primary and secondary students, allowing them to become the social innovators of tomorrow.



HOT HOUSE EDUCATION RESOURCE

Our technical, manufacturing and buildings teams does not just produce, market and sell insulation. Working with Sheffield Hallam University school of Science Education, developed the HOT HOUSE education resource. The HOT HOUSE encompasses National Curriculum learning objectives - ideas and concepts about the importance of energy saving and low carbon of eco insulation products.



Initial trials have been successfully conducted by teachers in schools in Sheffield and Yorkshire area and training teachers at Sheffield Hallam University.

The resource will be promoted via a video funded by the Social Enterprise Exchange program which supports social enterprise in Sheffield City Region via a community-based consortium in collaboration with Sheffield City Region Growth Hub and funded by European Regional Development Fund 2014-2020.
